Clarity Haynes' Breast Portrait Project is a social practice-based project exploring the body as a site for portraiture. Recent exhibitions include SELECT 2014, Artispace, VA; The Last Brucennial, The Bruce High Quality Foundation, NYC; Permanency: Selections from the Permanent Collection, The Leslie Lohman Museum of Lesbian and Gay Art, NYC; Summer Portrait Invitational, Life on Mars Gallery, Brooklyn; and Magic Praxis: Improvised Showboat #10, Industry City, Brooklyn. Her work is currently on view at the New Bedford Art Museum, MA, in A Collective Body: Uncovered and Illuminated, through November 13, 2015. Awards include the Community Arts Regrant Award from the Brooklyn Arts Council and the New York City Department of Cultural Affairs, and the Window of Opportunity Grant from the Leeway Foundation. Haynes' work has been reviewed in The Huffington Post, Two Coats of Paint, Juxtapoz Magazine, and Beautiful/Decay Magazine. She is represented in the Brooklyn Museum's Feminist Art Base, and she writes for Hyperallergic. Haynes lives in New York and teaches at Brooklyn College.
